

## Common asked questions about safety regarding wireless phone use.

### What about the safety of living or working near a wireless facility?

Scientists all over the world continually study the potential health effect of RF energy. These studies conclude that there is no evidence that RF from wireless facilities poses a public health threat. The RF emission from a typical cell site is a minuscule percentage (.0001%) of what the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) allows. It would take several thousand cell sites at a location to even come close to reaching the limits allowed by the FCC.

### Are there regulations about RF that protect public health?

The wireless industry is tightly regulated by the FCC which sets and enforces very conservative, science-based RF emission guidelines to protect public health. As you can see in the below chart, a cell tower installation is considerably below other commonly accepted forms of communication.
