- 1. Meeting called to order by Keefe at 5:02 PM
- 2. Roll Call-Shelby, Meyer, Keefe, Bayley, Chie present. Linville arrived at 5:10 PM. Others present were deputy supervisor Tobler, trustee Howard and resident Pete Hafler.
- 3. Motion by Keefe, support Shelby to approve March 20, 2018 regular meeting minutes. Motion passed unanimously.
- 4. Purchased water volume versus water sold volume discrepancy update-latest data showed that water purchased versus water sold showed an 8% loss compared to over 30% prior to the Czinski Road private line leak repair.
- 5. Water meter make and model update in BS&A active customer list-UMS has started gathering info from D and B billing.
- 6. Leak detection proposal-Tabled, OHM still collecting information.
- 7. Purchased sewer volume versus sewer service sold discrepancy-Discussed impact of Whittaker Rd. sewer collapse on meter. Meter was damaged after collapse. Measured flow for quarter 2 was slightly less than last year and was about even with 2016.
- 8. Dollar bill acceptor for bulk water dispenser-Deputy supervisor Tobler passed out a quote he received. Tabled so supervisor can speak to Rawsonville Rd. car wash owners about reliability and security.
- 9. WIFIA Infrastructure grant discussion-OHM brought this grant opportunity for discussion. Grant is for water and sewer projects and covers 49% of the \$5 million minimum project size. To be discussed in more detail next month. Supervisor to bring fund balances to the committee to assess financial viability.
- 10. UCMR4 sample-Samples collected after Township receives sample bottles, usually about a week prior to due date.
- 11. YCUA sanitary sewer repair update-YCUA still waiting on road closure permits.
- 12. New business
 - Discussed having a Residential Equivalency Unit (REU) component added to the bimonthly invoice. The Committee expects more discussion next month.
 - b. Discussed the meter replacement project. Committee consensus was to hold off a year or so to determine water loss due to aging meters now that a major leak (Czinski Rd.) was repaired.
 - c. Discussed getting more information to the Township board.
